FY11 Membership Requirements

Employers in Safety Council make a commitment to:

- Learn techniques for increasing safety in your workplace.
- Learn how to better manage your workers' compensation program.
- Network with other employers in your community.
- Access useful, money-saving workers' comp and risk management information.

Membership Eligibility Requirements:

- Join Safety Council by July 31, 2010.
- Attend 10 safety council meetings, at least 8 through the Huron County Safety Council. Employers have the option to gain credit for up to two meetings through attendance at WCU, Ohio Safety Congress, DSH safety training courses or industry specific training. (Safety training conducted at the employers' workplace, online or required by Drug-Free Workplace training does not qualify for program eligibility.)
- Have a senior-level manager attend one of the required safety council sponsored meetings. Attendance counts as credit toward one of the 10 required meetings.
- Submit semiannual workplace accident reports for the 2010 calendar year.
- Get a 2-percent rebate on your premiums by being an active member of Huron County Safety Council. Reducing either the severity or frequency of injuries in your workplace by 10 percent, or keep both at zero, and you can earn an additional 2-percent performance bonus rebate. (Rebate offer excludes self-insuring employers, state agencies and employers enrolled in BWC's group-rating and group-retrospective programs. Limitations apply to a professional employer organization.)
- Full FY11 BWC Requirements will be forwarded when available.
